State Road 123 Project News from the Florida Department of Transportation

The \$48 million widening and resurfacing project on State Road (S.R.) 123 in Okaloosa County includes constructing a new two-lane roadway to the west of and parallel to the existing travel lanes from S.R. 85 near the Northwest Florida Regional Airport to S.R. 85 north of Niceville.

Also included in the project are the constructions of new bridges over Toms Creek, Turkey Creek and an unnamed tributary, a fly over ramp at the S.R. 123/85 intersection near Niceville, environmental upgrades, drainage enhancements and landscaping. The efforts will increase capacity and improve traffic flow along this heavily traveled highway. The entire corridor is slated for completion spring 2016.
